 - When the PowerPoint tells you to, watch the "Anger Management: Rage on a Plane" video.
After you watch the video, answer the following questions:
 - i. What different tones of voice did you hear in the video?
 - ii. What body language did you see in the video?
 - iii. What were people wearing in the video?
 - iv. What were some of the repeated words you heard in the video?
 - Continue with the PowerPoint and when it tells you to, watch the "Genie Transforms Aladdin" video.
After you watch the video, answer the following questions:
 - i. Who in the video was being aggressive? How could you tell?
 - ii. Who in the video was being passive? How could you tell?
 - iii. Who in the video was being assertive? How could you tell?
